# Introducing our new quality standard

We're thrilled to announce a new quality standard that we're rolling out. This new standard asks you to include a follow-on activity that teachers can use a couple of weeks after the initial Neon activity. The goal is to make sure your activity has a lasting impact. The new standard is:

#### "Support teachers in enabling young people to reflect on the content of the Neon experience they have taken part in after the activity"

Research shows that follow-up activities really help students understand and remember what they've learned. By reflecting on their experiences, students can solidify their knowledge, make connections to real-world situations, and develop a deeper appreciation for the subject. This aligns perfectly with our mission to provide quality experiences that inspire and engage students.

- **Building connections:** reflection helps students make connections between the activity and their broader educational journey, enhancing their overall learning experience
